SUBJECT: "IF" Accounts Now Required for Using Lab
DATE Thursday, October 21, 1993

The networking in the College of Fine Arts Microcomputer Laboratory (FAML) is complete except for a final item of hardware. We expect that item to arrive any day. The network will allow us to realize the full potential of the lab, but will also necessitate two important changes.

1. **All FAML users will now need a Computation Center "IF" (Individually Funded) account to use the lab.**

For more information, and to establish an "IF" account, please go to the Computation Center accounting office, located in COM 27 (i.e. under the steps between the W. C. Hogg Building and Garrison Hall that lead up to the main mall area).

2. Once the network is completed, users will be required to pay for printing. (Printing has previously been free because the network was not complete.) You must now have an "IF" account to use the lab; to print in or from the FAML, you will need to have funds in your "IF" account sufficient to cover printing costs.

To avoid an interruption in your use of the FAML, you should establish your "IF" account at the Computation Center within the next few days.
