S.B. 14 Heman Sweatt

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE HEMAN SWEATT SYMPOSIUM ON CIVIL RIGHTS.

Be It Enacted by The Student Senate of The University of Texas:

SECTION I: There is hereby appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000.) to the Committee for the Heman Sweatt Symposium on Civil Rights from the Special Projects fund.

SECTION II: The money is to be used for any purpose necessary to make the Conference a reality.

SECTION III: The Financial Director may require an itemized statement from the Committee detailing in what fashion the money was spent.

SECTION IV: The Financial Director shall disburse the above sum to the Committee at their request.

SECTION V: If any portion of this Act is held invalid, the remainder shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION VI: This Act shall have immediate effect from the date of its passage.

SECTION VII: The Chair of the Senate Minority Affairs Committee or his representative shall serve as the Students' Association representative on the Committee for the Heman Sweatt Symposium on Civil Rights for the 1987-88 administrative year.
