You may have read the announcement of the petroleum work by the U.S. Geological Survey. The U.S.G.S. has \$304,000 available for petroleum work this fiscal year which ends June, 1944, and they are anxious to obtain projects and a staff. Miser, Bag, Reaside, and Inlay are coming over to see us Thursday with respect to this program. It is possible that we will do some cooperative work. It is possible that your work in the vertebrates of the Gulf Coastal Plain may fit in this program. I shall let you know what I find out about it later.
