AB 5: The Allocation of All Remaining Funds in the 19, 29, 30, and 41 University Accounts and the External Checking Account Numbers 6800, 6804, and 6808 *passed by acclamation 5/3/05*

AB 6: Ensuring Broad Representation on University Committees *NO quorum*
 AB 6 amends the Constitution of the SG to require 2/3 approval by the Assembly for all external appointments, particularly appointments to University committees, to ensure broad representation of the entire student population.

AR 4: Providing Bilingual Documentation for the University *Passed by vote 23-2*
 AR 4 intends to better provide for the Spanish speaking community by supplying important information such as financial aid and orientation materials in Spanish. Bilingual documentation is common in campuses across the nation and has also been attributed to increasing Latino applicants. Because the Latino community has grown to become the largest minority present on campus, a need for bilingual documentation is clear and strong.
