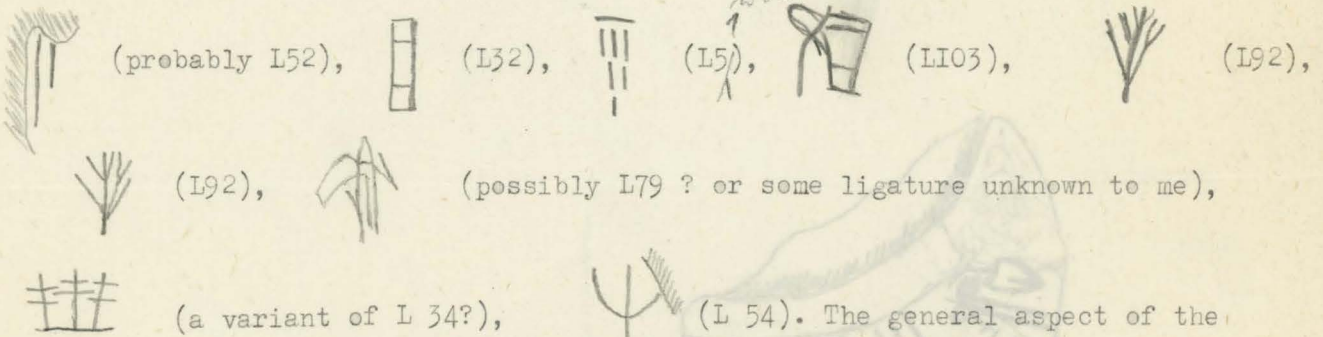

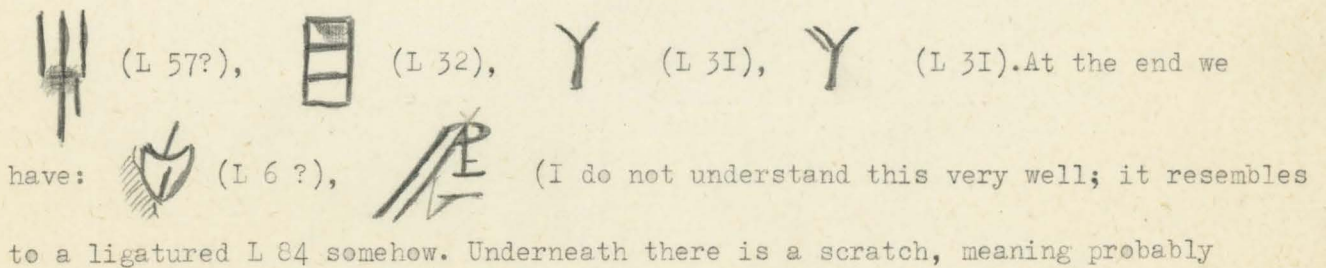
(i) Fragment of stone altar. On the rim are nine letters:



fragment looks like that:



(ii) Fragment of stepped pyramidal stone altar. We have probably the beginn and the end of the inscription, with an empty space between, exactly on the angle of the rim (or rather the border outside the rim). We have here six letters. I beginn from what I think is the beginning (I am afraid it is not exactly the libation formula!):




nothing more than a scratch but anyway reminding vaguely of L 68). This last area is a little damaged.
