A. B. 04 Establishing a Texas Center Ad Hoc Committee

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To create a committee of students charged with investigating the feasibility, costs, and general interest in implementing the Texas Center Proposal:

Be it enacted by the Assembly of the Student Government of the University of Texas:

SECTION ONE: The Assembly calls upon the President of the Assembly to appoint an Ad Hoc committee for the purpose of investigating the any Texas Center Proposal proposals. The President of the Assembly shall define the duties of the committee.

SECTION TWO: The committee shall be open to all members of the University.

SECTION THREE: The committee shall report its findings to the Assembly by the fourth regularly scheduled Assembly meeting in the fall of 2000.
