S.B. 15 Polis Computer

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES FROM THE GENERATED FUNDS TO PURCHASE A MAC INTOSH SE, KEYBOARD, AND IMAGEWRITER PRINTER.

Be It Enacted by The Student Senate of The University of Texas:

SECTION I: The sum of \$2359 is appropriated from generated funds for purchase of a MacIntosh SE, keyboard and Imagewriter printer.

SECTION II: The computer is to be purchased by the Financial Director for the production of Polis magazine.

SECTION III: The computer is to be stored and operated in the Polis office.

SECTION IV: If for any reason, Polis magazine should no longer require use of the computer, it will be stored and operated in the Students' Association office.

SECTION V: This Act shall have immediate effect from the date of passage.
