MOSQUITOS ATTACK ENGINE SHEDS

At dusk yesterday (Tuesday) Mosquito aircraft of Bomber Command attacked the engine sheds at RONET, two miles from Namur. These are among the largest engine sheds in Belgium and from their position must be in frequent use because five main railway lines meet at Namur. The sheds are strategically placed in large marshalling sidings.

The attack was designed to increase Germany's already acute shortage of locomotives.

The Mosquitos attacked from various heights and bombs were seen to burst on the sheds and the marshalling yards. As the crews turned for home smoke was seen rising to some 300 feet.
