 - a. AB 1 – In Support of Amending Student Government Code of Rules and Procedures Ex-Officio Member Privileges *passed by unanimous consent 4/26/16*
 - i. The purpose of this bill is to amend Section 1.5 (c) of the Code of Rules and Procedures to grant ex-officio members of the assembly the ability to make incidental and privileged motions. This will facilitate communication between the three branches of student government and will allow assembly meetings to run more efficiently.
 - b. AR 1 – In Support of Establishing the Naloxone Initiative for Opioid Emergencies at the University of Texas at Austin *Passed by unanimous consent 4/26/16*
 - i. UT Students for Sensible Drug Policy hopes to continue its push for on campus harm reduction policies by expanding naloxone access. The bill advocates for obtaining a standing order of naloxone from a nearby pharmacy. This would equip UTPD and RAs with a drug which reverses opioid overdose, which is increasingly common among 18-24 year olds.

- c. AR 2 – In Support of Incorporating the University of Texas at Austin Microfarm and Concho Community Garden into the East Campus Master Plan *Passed by unanimous consent 4/26/16*
 - i. The East Campus Master Plan may entail the demolition of both the UT Microfarm and Concho Community Garden in order to construct graduate student housing. Given the administration's support for green spaces and sustainable initiatives, the Microfarm and Concho should be incorporated into the East Campus Master Plan within the graduate student housing complex. Students and community members have demonstrated significant support for their preservation.

- d. AR 3 – In Support of Ballot Proposition 1 in The City of Austin's Special Election to be held on Saturday, May 7, 2016 *passed 25 yes 3 no 1 abstain 4/26/16*
