HOME GUARD FOR ANTI-AIRCRAFT DEFENCE

The War Office has decided, as a result of successful local experiments, to raise a large number of Home Guards to man special Anti-Aircraft batteries. Recruiting will, therefore, be opened at once for men to join Home Guard A.A. batteries which will be based on existing Home Guard formations in London and in many provincial centres.

Local ~~announcements~~ will be made in the centres concerned as soon as recruiting is opened, when applications should be made to the local Home Guard battalion, from whom all information can be obtained. No applications should be made to the War Office, since all arrangements will be handled locally.

Enrolment will be into the Home Guard under the usual conditions, except that service will be exclusively with an A.A. battery.

The uniform will be that of the Home Guard but the distinguishing "flash" of the parent A.A. Division will be worn.
