Mr. Bob H. Slaughter of the Shuler Museum of Paleontology of S.M.U. in Dallas asked me as a favor to him to send some fossil oyster shells to you.

I am very happy to be asked to participate in this as an amateur collector

I am sending, by Parcel Post, some fossil shells from the Woodbine and the Arapson of the Dallas-Ft. Worth Area.

The Woodbine oysters were collected in a road cut on Texas Hwy 360 approx. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile South of the Trinity River. They were taken from below the Bear Creek Formation in a sandy clay containing lignitized wood.

The Grayson oysters were collected on Highway 81 South of FT Worth, Texas in a new road cut. The Wood line - Grayson contact is visible in this cut. Oysters range from contact to 10-15 feet below in this cut.

If these are suitable specimens for your Project, please inform me and I will be happy to send other oysters. If you want specific ones please inform me.
